

CONGRESS INTERVIEWS

Description: Participants will prepare their 4-H Portfolio and submit it to the State 4-H Office by February 15th. Portfolios are a cumulative report of a 4-H member's experiences. The portfolios are then judged and the top individuals will be invited for an interview at State 4-H Contests. This is the only time interviews are offered.

Entries: Each person may submit one portfolio to be judged.

State Awards: The top individuals will receive a scholarship to attend the national event.

National Trip: National 4-H Congress is held in Atlanta, Georgia.
