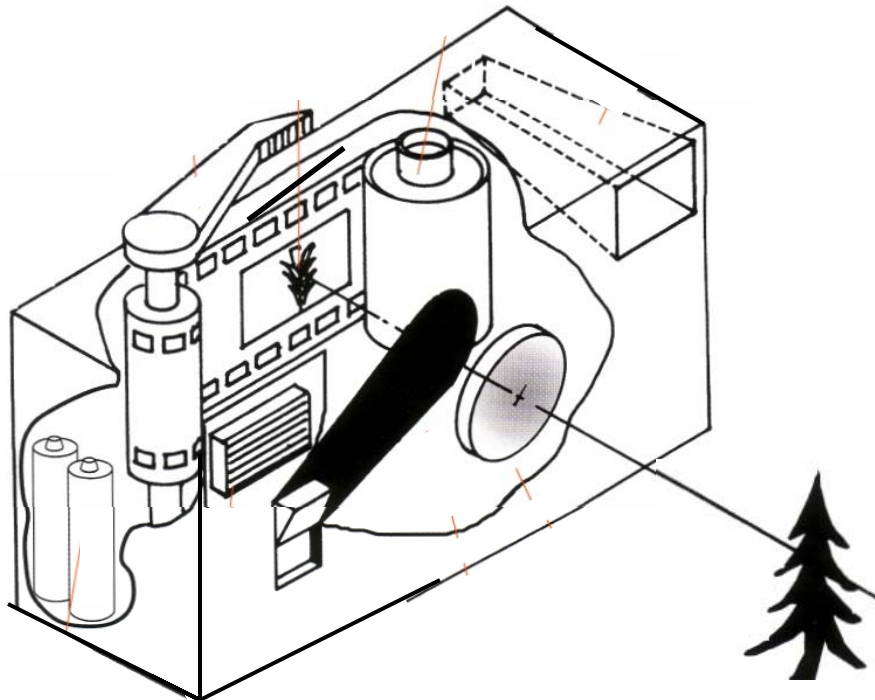


# What Part AM I?

## Parts of a camera

1. Lens
2. Flash
3. Shutter
4. Camera Body
5. Film
6. Wind Lever
7. View Finder
8. Camera Strap
9. Battery

- A. I am a part found inside a camera, like an eyelid that closes over an eye. I control the time that light reaches the film.
- B. I am a part that goes inside the camera to catch the image made from light. I'm made from plastic and chemicals.
- C. My light forms an image on film. I am made out of glass that collects light.
- D. On some cameras, you need to move me back and forth to wind your film.
- E. I am looked into that shows the picture before you take it.
- F. I make a quick, bright light.
- G. I am a major part that keeps all the other parts together.
- H. I am a very useful addition to the camera. I am made from a piece of ribbon or cloth that is attached to the camera body. I can be put around your neck.
- I. I provide energy for the electrical parts of the camera.
