

CHINESE WRITING

Items Needed: Sticks, pencil, anything that can be used for “writing”

1. Players sit in a circle. One player is chosen to be IT and sent from the room/area. Another player is selected to be the writer. (Someone who knows how the game works.)
2. The group picks a person’s name to be “written.” The writer puts the “writing pieces” down – this has nothing to do with the game but is needed to throw people off. The writer then copies everything that the person whose name was “written” does. (It is best if they have a unique posture or movement.) The rest of the group is told not to tell who it is, and to act natural.
3. The person comes back and tries to guess who’s name was written.
4. This can be repeated until all players understand how it is played.
