

GROUP JUGGLE

Items Needed: 6 or 7 crushed paper balls or rubber balls

1. Everyone stands in a circle about one arm's length apart.
2. The first player throws a ball to someone on the other side of the circle, calling out their name, who throws it to a third person, and so forth. This continues until the ball makes its way to everyone once and returns to the original person. Each player should receive the ball only once. Players are to remember to whom they throw the ball. When a pattern is set it is never broken throughout the game.
3. The leader throws the first ball. As the rhythm of the pattern becomes smoother and throwers and receivers get used to it, another ball is added, then a third, then a fourth. Players should be able to, depending on the size of the group, keep six or seven balls moving at once.
