

# FACE UP CARD TOSS

## Items Needed:

- One deck of playing cards
- An empty, large coffee can, or wash and dry the bottom half of a gallon milk jug
- Masking tape to mark throwing line

Players line up behind the throwing line to take a turn. The can/jug should be placed approximately 3 to 4 feet away.

In turn, each player is given one suit of a deck of cards (13 cards in all). She/he then pitches them one at a time, trying to get them to land inside the jug. Once all the cards have been pitched, the player tallies her/his score. Each card that lands in the jug is worth twice its face value. For instance, if a "7" went in, it would be worth 14 points. Cards that land face up on the floor around the jug are worth face value toward the score. The Jack, Queen, and King are each worth 12 points, and the Ace is worth 15 points in this game. Cards that land face down on the floor are worth zero points. Gather up the cards, and see if you can score higher next time.
